4. I will not take part if I have any doubt about my ability or safety of the venue.
5. I accept that the competition in motor sport may involve risk of injury or death and agree to take part at my own risk.
6. Before taking part in the event I will read and be bound by and comply with the general regulations, any supplement and final instructions issued by the AMCA, the organisers and the circuit owners and regulatory body.
7. I will not participate whilst under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating drugs and that I am taking any prescribed medication I will inform the event organiser and seek approval to participate before taking part.

No refunds after the closing date without a legitimate reason. If a rider cancels their entry prior to the event then a £1.25 cancellation fee for admin would be charged. The refund will not be processed until after the event.

Refunds will be given if the event is cancelled by the Club.

Behaviour: The officials of the meeting are all volunteers and deserve to be treated with respect. Any rider(s) that abuses any official or ignores their instruction will be excluded from the rest of the meeting and are subject to penalties as defined in the AMCA Rulebook. Riders are also responsible for the behavior of any persons attending with them. Their behavior will also render the rider liable to such action.
