Declaration: Motor sport can be dangerous and may involve injury or death. You must read and agree to the following declaration and paragraphs below which are designed to create a legal binding relationship in return for being allowed to enter and compete.

My entrant's signature confirms that the information in this entry form is my acceptance of the terms of my competition licence is correct.

1. I confirm that I understand the nature of the competition I am entering and I am competent to take part.
2. I confirm that any vehicle I use will comply with the regulations and will be safe and fit for use in the competition.
3. Before taking part in the event I will ensure (Unless prohibited) that I have inspected the venue, the track and facilities and geographical features and that I am satisfied that it is safe for me to complete.
4. I will not take part if I have any doubt about my ability or safety of the venue.
5. I accept that the competition in motor sport may involve risk of injury or death and agree to take part at my own risk.
6. Before taking part in the event I will read and be bound by and comply with the general regulations, any supplement and final instructions issued by the AMCA, the organisers and the circuit owners and regulatory body.
7. I will not participate whilst under the influence of alcohol or intoxicating drugs and that I am taking any prescribed medication I will inform the event organiser and seek approval to participate before taking part.

Behaviour: The officials of the meeting are all volunteers and deserve to be treated with respect. Any rider(s) that abuses any official or ignores their instruction will be excluded from the rest of the meeting and are subject to penalties as defined in the AMCA Rulebook. Riders are also responsible for the behaviour of any persons attending with them. Their behaviour will also render the rider liable to such action.
